1. In this episode, Francis Schaeffer is quoted as saying, “The Christian is one whose imagination should fly beyond the stars.” What do you think of that quote? How have you seen this be true in your life?
2. What opportunities have you seen COVID-19 pandemic opening up for you to be involved, using your specific gifts, talents, and calling?
3. History of pandemics shows us that the church often flourishes the most when the odds are stacked against it. Can you think of a way you have seen the church flourish during this most current pandemic?
4. Jaime Saint says that, “God made us in His image. He made us to be creative. He gives us ideas to meet problems, and by meeting those problems we have the opportunity to tell people who God is.” Reflect and share some examples where someone has met a need, which then led them to be able to share God with another person.
